Modern Color
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(F)

From a print fabric, cut:
5 squares, 2" $\times 2^{\prime \prime}$. (A)

From the solid or semi-solid fabric to go between the print squares, cut:
1 square $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ ". Cut through the center horizontally and vertically to make 4 squares, each 2" x 2". (B)

## From another solid or semi-solid fabric, cut:

1 square, 4" x 4". Cut through the center horizontally and vertically; then cut diagonally from corner to corner to yield 8 triangles. (C).

Leave Piece (D) white; that is, empty, OR choose a light-value fabric.


Cut 8.

Leave Piece (E) empty, OR cut 1 square 4" x 4 " both ways to yield 4 squares, each $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ ".
In my block, these squares are white with a wavy black stripe.

From the corner fabric (black with a white design in my quilt), cut:
1 square, $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$. Cut through the center horizontally and vertically to yield 4 squares, each 2"x 2" (F).
